1st Canadian Young Physicists' Tournament

Do you love physics?

Do you want a chance to compete in the 'Physics World Cup'?

CaYPT is the Canadian national platform for the International Young Physicists' Tournament (IYPT). IYPT ('Physics World Cup') is a team-oriented scientific competition among teams of secondary school students. The teams are composed of 3-5 students in which they present their solutions to scientific problems they have prepared by researching and experimenting. The teams then discuss their solutions with other teams in a debate form. The roles of Reporter (Presentation), Opponent and Reviewer are graded by a jury consisting of international experts.

The Ontario regional tournament will be held on March 25, 2017 at the Perimeter Institute for Theoretical Physics (other regional tournaments date and location TBD), and the national tournament will take place on an online platform (date TBD).

The winner of the national CaYPT will be given the opportunity to proceed to the 30th IYPT hosted by the National University of Singapore from July 5-12, 2017.
